Boom Baby Boom Exhibition

This exhibition was organised by the *Bundaberg Arts Centre*, and its mission is stated as presenting

"a quality contemporary exhibition of visual art with strong educational content based on the impact and influence of the Baby Boomer generation and to highlight the importance and vitality of art and culture in the Bundaberg region."

This work by Seth Keen is an extension to the Hazzard's Project.
