If your time at the exhibition is limited, here are a few suggestions to get you started.

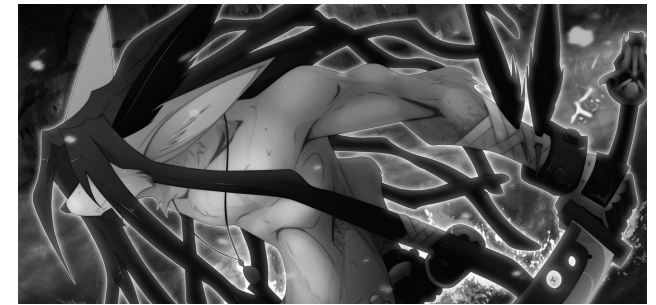
